ROAD CLOSING ADVISORY

PennDot and PALO Construction have announced the Newry Bridge, located just north of Leighty's Farm Market on Dunnings Highway will be <u>CLOSED</u> at <u>7:00PM</u> beginning <u>Sunday, July 15, 2018</u> while a new bridge is constructed at that location.

Construction on the new bridge is expected to take about two weeks.

Thru traffic using SR 3013 Dunnings Highway will be detoured approximately 8.1 miles as a result. The detour route will be clearly signed closer to the closing date.

Work on this project includes the replacement of the existing structure with a single span composite steel I-Beam bridge. Drainage and guiderail upgrades will also take place, along with minor roadway approach work. There will also be some sidewalk installation along the west side of the bridge towards Newry as well as curb and curb gutter installed on the Leighty's side of the roadway.

Access to homes and businesses via SR 3013 from the Learnersville intersection to the Newry Bridge will remain open.

The Blair Township Police Department urges motorists using SR 3013 to follow the detoured route, plan ahead and allow extra travel time for possible delays, slow down and obey the posted speed limits and all traffic laws, be patient and above all; be nice to your fellow motorists.
